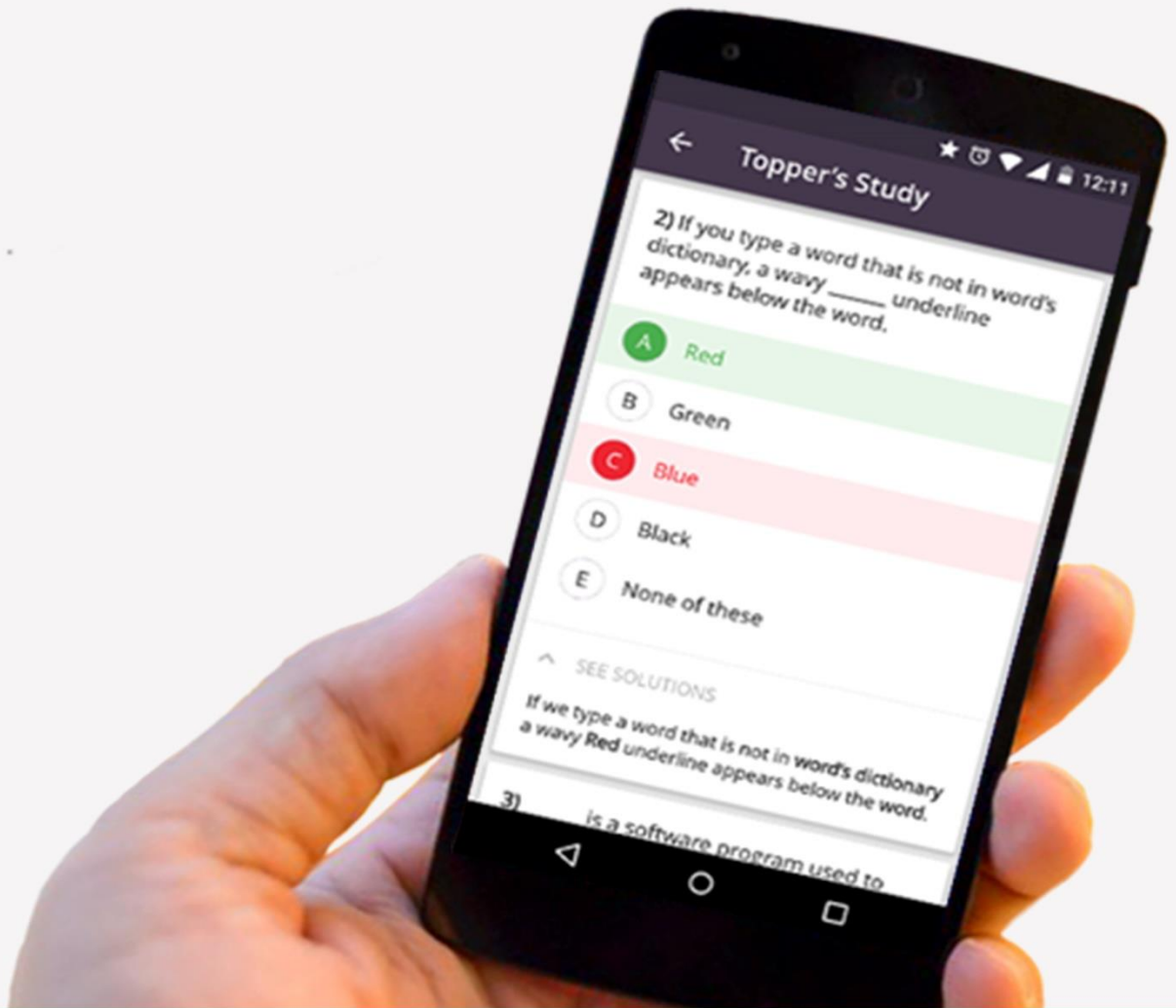

**Banking & Financial Awareness**

1. The Union Government has signed the loan agreement to improve Assam's Power Distribution with\_\_\_**Asian Development Bank**.



- **Asian Development Bank** will provide the second tranche loan of **USD 48 million** to Assam to help the state expand and upgrade its power distribution system.
- This is the second tranche loan of the **USD 300 million** multi-tranche financing facility for the Assam Power Sector Investment Programme that was approved by the ADB Board in July 2014.

2. Who has announced that Rs. 500 and Rs. 1,000 notes will cease to be legal tender\_\_\_**PM Narendra Modi**.



- The demonetization drive of these two currency units (Rs. 500 and Rs. 1,000 notes) was taken to root out the menace of black money and fake currency from the country.
- The currency notes of 100, 50, 20, 10, 5, 2 and 1 rupee will remain unaffected by this decision and remain legal tender.

3. Who has inaugurated Economic Editors' Conference-2016 in New Delhi\_\_\_**Arun Jaitley**.



- The Main objective of holding the Conference is to apprise the media persons about the major policy initiatives, achievements and future road map of different participating Departments and Ministries of the Government.
- Press Information Bureau (PIB) in collaboration with the Ministry of Finance is organizing the Conference.

4. Reserve Bank of India (RBI) hands over West Bengal govt. list of entities raising money illegally\_\_\_**194**.



- RBI has also cautioned the state government that in absence of an immediate crackdown, the activities of such entities can trigger another Saradha-like financial scam.
- The apex bank has also handed over to the state government supportive documents about these 194 dubious entities.

5. The Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) in the country increased by how many percent to 5.15 billion Dollar in September 2016\_\_\_**77.5%**.



- FDI had stood at 2.9 billion Dollar in September last year.
- Services received the maximum FDI of 2.29 billion dollar during the first half of this fiscal, followed by telecommunications, trading, computer software and hardware and automobile.

6. India has pledged howw many dollar for development activities across several UN (United Nation) bodies for the year 2017\_\_\_about **10.95 million**.



- It including 4.5 million dollar for the UN Development Programme, 1.92 million dollar for the World Food Programme, 1.25 million dollar for the UN Relief and Works Agency for Near East and a million dollars towards UN Women.

7. The Union government has introduced the new series of how many denomination notes at the SBI Parliament Street Branch in New Delhi\_\_ **500 Rupees.**



- State Chief Secretaries to identify the rural pockets where availability of cash is a problem and provide all support to the Banks and Post Offices to ensure the last mile distribution is done through mobile banking vans and Banking Correspondents.
- Now, Customer can make a complaint to concerned District Magistrate and District Administration for action against such establishments.

8. India’s first banking robot “Lakshmi” has been launched by the Kumbakonam-based \_\_ **City Union Bank.**



- The artificial intelligence powered robot “**Lakshmi**” can speak English, gesture and engage in a life-like manner in conversations.
- The robot can interact with customers on more than 125 subjects including account balance and interest rates on loans.

1. The World Science Day for Peace and Development (WSDPD) is observed \_\_\_\_ **10th November.**



- The day highlights the important role of science in society and the need to engage the wider public in debates on emerging scientific issues.
- The 2016 WSDPD is celebrated with the theme “Celebrating Science Centres and Science Museums”.

2. The Public Service Broadcasting Day is observed in India\_\_\_\_ **12th November.**



- The Father of the Nation Mahatma Gandhi visited the studio of All India Radio, Delhi for the first and last time.

3. The World Pneumonia Day (WPD) is observed every year on \_\_\_\_ **12th November.**



- The day provide an annual forum for the world to stand together and demand action in the fight against pneumonia.
- The 2016 theme is “Keep the Promise, Stop Pneumonia Now”

4. Children’s Day is celebrated 14th November every year on the birth anniversary of \_\_ **Jawaharlal Nehru.**



- Children’s Day is celebrated across India to increase awareness of the rights, care and education of children.
- Children’s Day (Bal Diwas) was first celebrated in 1964 after the death of Pandit Nehru

5. The World Diabetes Day (WDD) is observed every year on \_\_\_\_ **14th November.**



- The theme of WDD 2016 is “Eyes on Diabetes”.
- This year the focus will be on promoting the importance of screening to ensure early diagnosis of type 2 diabetes and treatment to reduce the risk of serious complications.

### New Appointments

1. Who has been appointed as the new CEO and MD of Bank of Baroda Capital Markets Ltd.\_\_\_\_ **Ratnesh Kumar.**



- Kumar has also held the position of CEO of Standard Chartered Securities India.
- BOB Capital Market Ltd is the investment banking subsidiary of the state run, Bank of Baroda.

2. Who has been appointed as Executive Director by RBI (Reserve Bank of India)\_\_\_\_ **Rajeshwar Rao.**



- Mr. Rao has been appointed to look after the Department of Statistics and Information Management, Financial Markets Operation Department and International Department.
- The appointment was made after **G Mahalingam** opted for voluntary retirement from the central bank.

3. Who has been appointed as CEO – Retail by Airtel\_\_ **Vani Venkatesh**.



- She will look after Airtel’s retail strategy to deliver a seamless customer experience.
- The appointment was made by Bharti Airtel after Rohit Malhotra stepped down from the post.

4. Who will become the 45th United States President after a stunning victory over Democrat Hillary Clinton\_\_ **Donald Trump**.



- Mr. Trump’s shock victory in Wisconsin that put him over the 270 out of 538 electoral college votes needed to win the White House.
- He is scheduled to take office as the 45th President on 20th January, 2017.
- He was born and raised in New York City and received a bachelor’s degree in economics from the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania in 1968.

5. Who has been appointed as the Chairman of Fund Trustee and Advisory Commission of Kerala(FTAC)\_\_ **Vinod Rai**.



- He will be entrusted with the responsibility to ensure that the funds of the Kerala Infrastructure Investment Fund Board (KIIFB) are properly utilized and the interest of investors is protected.
- The FTAC will have a two-year term and the members cannot be removed either by the government or the KIIFB.

6. Who has been nominated as the interim chairman of TCS in place of Cyrus Mistry\_\_ **Ishaat Hussain**.



- Currently, Ishaat Hussain serving as the chairman of Voltas and satellite television provider Tata Sky.
- Tata Sons owned a 73.26 percent stake in TCS and Mistry whose family controls an 18.41 percent stake in Tata Sons.

7. Who has been elected as the director-general of the International Labour Organization (ILO)\_\_ **Guy Ryder**.



- Guy Ryder has been re-elected Director-General of the International Labour Organisation (ILO) for a second five-year term that will start officially on October 1, 2017.
- The headquarters of ILO is at Geneva, Switzerland.

8. Who has been appointed as MD & CEO of Central Registry of Securitisation Asset Reconstruction and Security Interest of India\_\_ **Praveen Kumar Sharma**.



- Sharma is General Manager, State Bank of India.
- **CERSAI** is providing the platform for filing registrations of transactions of securitisation, asset reconstruction and security interest by the banks and financial institutions.

9. Who has been appointed as the brand ambassador of Switzerland tourism\_\_ **Ranveer Singh**.



- The Syrian journalist has been honour for reporting from some of the most perilous zones in his country during the five year war.
- The competition was organised by the National Innovation Foundation to focus on the creativity of the children and promote inclusive thinking among them.

10. Who has been elected as the President of the International Hockey Federation(IHF)\_\_ **Narinder Batra**.





- He has defeated David Balbirnie of Ireland and Australia's Ken Read to become the 12th FIH President and also the first Asian to grab the post.
- Batra succeeds Spaniard Leandro Negre, who has been the IHF chief since 2008.

11. Who has been elected as the International Criminal Police Organization (INTERPOL)\_\_\_**Meng Hongwei**.



- Hongwei will take over the position from his predecessor Mireille Ballestrazzi (France).
- He has been elected for a period of four years.
- INTERPOL is the world's largest international police organization, with 190 member countries.

12. The committee has been constituted by the Supreme Court (SC) to verify the availability of night shelters\_\_\_**Kailash Gambhir committee**.



- The committee will submit its report within **4 months**.
- Justice Gambhir is the former Delhi High Court judge.

13. Who is the new Whole-Time Member (WTM) of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI)\_\_\_ **Gurumoorthy Mahalingam**.



- He has become the new Whole-Time Member (WTM) of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) for a period of 5 years or till the age of 65 years , whichever is earliest.

1. Who has launched the “Healthy India Initiative” magazine and “No More Tension” mobile App for promotion of health and to strengthen the health communications programmes in New Delhi\_\_\_ **Jagat Prakash Nadda**.



- ✓ The app was launched for promotion of health and to strengthen the health communications programmes.
- ✓ Healthy India Magazine will be a quarterly magazine and it will cater to health related information.
- ✓ The main objective of ‘No More Tension’ is to provide information to users regarding stress such as, what is stress, effects, symptoms and its management.

2. Who has launched “Pradhan Mantri Yuva Yojana” (PMYY) to scale up an ecosystem of entrepreneurship for youngsters\_\_\_**Rajiv Pratap Rudy**.



- PMYY is MSDE's flagship scheme on entrepreneurship education and training.
- The scheme spans over five years with a project cost of 499.94 crore rupees.
- It will provide entrepreneurship education and training to over 7 lakh students in 5 years through 3,050 institutes.

3. Who has launched ‘Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana’ in Punjab\_\_\_**Dharmendra Pradhan**.



- Seven lakh pending families of Punjab will be provided free gas connections under the scheme which will make Punjab 100% kitchen smoke-free.
- Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas is set to extend benefit of the scheme to 1.5 crore beneficiaries during the current financial year 2016-17.

4. Who has inaugurated the world's largest digital national building initiative “Smart India Hackathon 2017” by handing over a torch to technology students\_\_\_**Prakash Javadekar**.



- The ‘Smart India Hackathon 2017’ is a pan-India 36-hour nonstop digital programming competition which will take place in more than 20 centres simultaneously.
- The Hackathon will have nearly 500 problem statements in all which will be published on innovate.mygov.in.

5. The 36th edition of India International Trade Fair (IITF) has been inaugurated at \_\_\_\_ **Pragati Maidan, New Delhi.**



- IITF fair (14th-27th November) will provide information on various schemes including Swachh Bharat Campaign, Clean Ganga Mission, Jan-Dhan Yojana, Skill India, Crop Insurance, Start up and Stand up Campaign.
- This year over 150 companies from 27 countries are taking part in the fair and the Partner Country is South Korea while the Focus Country is Belarus.
- The theme of IITF-2016 is “Digital India”.

6. Indian firm has won the 2016 Golden Peacock Award for Corporate Governance \_\_\_\_ **Steel Authority of India Limited (SAIL).**



- The award was received by Ashwini Kumar, CEO of Rourkela Steel Plant (RSP) on behalf of SAIL during the 16th London Global Convention on Corporate Governance and Sustainability in London, United Kingdom (UK).

### States News

1. The three-day (9-11th) Global Rajasthan Agritech Meet GRAM has begun in the city of Rajasthan \_\_\_\_ **Jaipur.**



- The main objective of the meet is to double the income of farmers through various technologies and agriculture activities.
- Farmer will be informed about new technology and other agriculture related activities and representatives will share their new technology and agriculture activities with state’s farmers.

2. Who has started Deendayal generic medicine stores to sell generic medicines in the state \_\_\_\_ **Gujarat government.**



- It will remain open 24 hours and sell around 1,000 generic drugs to the poor patients at 40 to 80 % lower rates.
- Mobile application ‘G-Dava’ will act as a search engine for information on branded and generic medicines, price difference, chemical composition, availability, etc.

3. 1st Indian National Open Accuracy Paragliding takes off in \_\_\_\_ **Himachal Pradesh.**



- 107 pilots from 15 countries took part in the first Indian National Open Accuracy Paragliding Championship at Bir-Billing Dharamsala (Himachal Pradesh).
- Nine women paragliders (Indians-3) will also compete in the four-day international meet.

4. India’s first LNG-powered bus has been launched in the state \_\_\_\_ **Kerala.**



- The LNG-driven bus has rolled out as part of the Union Government’s plans to use LNG.
- Liquefied natural gas is natural gas that has been converted to liquid form for ease of storage or transport.

### Important News – World

1. Mission of NASA that created Guinness World Record for highest altitude fix of GPS signal \_\_\_\_ **Magnetospheric Multiscale Mission.**



- This space record has been set by the 4 MMS satellites by using GPS navigation at an altitude of 43,500 miles (70,000 kilometers) above Earth's surface.

2. Who has decided to procure ten diesel engines from RITES India Ltd. \_\_\_ **Sri Lankan government**.



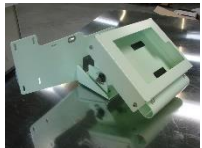
- The engines will be purchased at a cost of 4.25 million US dollars each and will be supplied over the period of next two years.
- Over 1 billion US dollars of LoC has been extended to Sri Lanka for various railway projects.

3. 2nd BRICS Communication Ministers meeting was held in \_\_\_ **Bengaluru**.



- The meeting will discuss ways to improve collaboration in the field of digital economy, future communications, mobile technology among other things.
- The High-Level delegation from Brazil, Russia, India, China and South Africa will deliberate for greater cooperation in Telecommunication and ICT sectors.

4. The Union Government has issued guidelines for suspension or banning of business dealings in \_\_\_ **Armament Sector**.



- The Defence Acquisitions Council (DAC) has approved the guidelines for suspension or banning of business dealings with arms companies.
- The **Union Government** will no longer impose blanket bans on armament companies suspected of corruption.

5. The two newly identified biomarkers that will help in easy diagnosis of drug resistant Tuberculosis \_\_\_ **miR-16 and miR-155**.



- Researchers has identified two biomarkers in serum samples that could help in TB diagnosis and TB disease prognosis.
- The identified microRNA biomarkers could be used for drug-sensitive pulmonary TB and multi-drug resistant TB (MDR-TB) patients.

4. Who has successfully launched a navigation satellite XPNAV-1 \_\_\_ **China**.



- The satellite will undergo tests on its detector functions and space environment adaptability.
- The satellite will help reduce the spacecraft's reliance on ground-based navigation methods and is expected to lead to autonomous spacecraft navigation in the future.

5. Who has announced the national rollout of an online programme for preschoolers to learn foreign languages for promoting languages other than English, including Hindi from next year onward \_\_\_ **Australia**.



- The government would extend the programme to offer Australian preschoolers the opportunity to learn Italian and Spanish in 2017 and Hindi and Modern Greek in 2018.

6. Who has become the first non-NPT country with which Japan has signed a Civil Nuclear Agreement \_\_\_ **India**.



- The deal would allow Japan to export nuclear technology to India and boost bilateral economic and security ties and facilitate US-based players to set up atomic plants in India.
- India has already signed civil nuclear deal with ten other countries (United States, Russia, Mongolia, South Korea, France, Australia, Namibia, Kazakhstan, Argentina and Canada).

7. The Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) Forum's Week started at \_\_\_ **Lima in Peru**.



- It will bring together leaders of world’s largest economies, businessmen and investors.
- A creation of Free Trade Area of the Asia-Pacific is one of the main topics on the agenda of the 2016 APEC Summit that is widely seen as the premier business event drawing together business and economic leaders of 21 Pacific Rim countries.

3. Mike McCormack from Ireland has won the 2016 Goldsmiths Prize for his novel \_\_\_\_ **Solar Bones.**



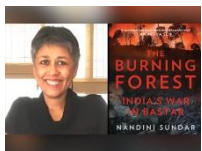
- It is awarded to a book that is deemed genuinely novel and which embodies the spirit of invention that characterizes the genre at its best.

- Narayan Dutt Tiwari was thrice Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh (1976-77, 1984-85, 1988-89) and once Chief Minister of Uttarakhand (2002-2007).

6. Who has been anointed as Business Person of the Year for 2016 \_\_\_ **Mark Zuckerberg**.



- Zuckerberg's social network Facebook is used by nearly 1.8 billion people around the world.
- Amazon CEO Jeff Bezos has recognised second for dominating e-commerce and for breaking new ground by developing products such as the Amazon Echo.

7. Who will be honoured with the Tata Literature Live! Poet Laureate Award for 2016 \_\_\_ **Gulzar**.



- The award carries a citation, plaque and cash prize and will be presented to him at Tata Literature Live!'s annual awards ceremony to be held on November 17, 2016 at the National Centre for the Performing Arts (NCPA), Nariman Point, Mumbai.

8. Madhya Pradesh government's prestigious Rashtriya Kalidas Samman will be given to eminent theatre artists \_\_\_ **Raj Bisaria and Banshi Kaul**.



- The committee unanimously chose Shri Raj Bisaria and Shri Banshi Kaul for the awards unanimously for the year 2015-16 and 2016-17 respectively.
- Both the dramatists, to be awarded with Rashtriya Kalidas Samman, are known for long-cherished practice, excellence and continuous creative activeness in the country.

9. An Indian-origin man in South Africa has been awarded the prestigious Global Citizen Award by international citizenship advisory firm Henley & Partners \_\_\_ **Dr. Imtiaz Sooliman**.



- **Sooliman** is the founder of the **internationally-lauded Gift** of the Givers Foundation.
- The award consists of a specially-made commemorative medal, an award certificate and a \$ 50,000 monetary prize, of which \$ 25,000 is donated to the UN High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR).

## Obituaries

1. The First female U.S. Attorney General who passes away\_\_\_**Janet Reno.**



- Janet Wood Reno served as the Attorney General of the United States from 1993 until 2001
- She was also the second-longest serving Attorney General in U.S. history, after William Wirt.

2. Canadian singer-songwriter who seamlessly blended spirituality and sexuality in songs like Hallelujah, Suzanne and Bird on a Wire has passed away \_\_\_**Leonard Cohen.**



- He also wrote novels such as The Favourite Game (1963) and Beautiful Losers (1966).
- In 1967 he released Songs Of Leonard Cohen and followed it with Songs From A Room in 1969 and Songs Of Love And Hate (1971).

3. Noted geophysicist who passed away in Hyderabad\_\_\_\_**Janardhan Negi**



- Negi was the former Director-grade scientist at the National Geophysical Research Institute (NGRI).
- He was also known for making the outstanding contribution in understanding earthquakes, mass extinctions, especially dinosaurs and the movement of the Indian sub-continent plates.

## Sports News

1. Who has scored fastest hundred in Indian first class cricket\_\_\_**Rishabh Pant.**



- The wicketkeeper and batsman from Delhi was playing in the Ranji Trophy against Jharkhand.
- He hit the century off **48 balls.**

2. Who has won the 33rd Indian Oil Servo Surjit Hockey Tournament by defeating Haryana \_\_\_**Western Railways women's team.**



- The winners were presented a cash award of 1 lakh rupee and trophy and runners-up got 75000 rupees and Trophy.
- Jaspreet Kaur of Haryana XI was declared the best player of the tournament.

3. Who has reclaimed the World Boxing Organization welterweight title for the third time in Las Vegas, USA\_\_\_Filipino southpaw Manny Pacquiao.



- He was given unanimous decision victory over former champion Jesse Vargas in his comeback fight.
- Earlier, Pacquiao won the WBO title for the first time in 2010 when he beat Miguel Cotto.

4. India wushu team has bagged how many medals in the eighth Sanda World Cup held at Xian, China\_\_ **five medals.**



- World silver medalist Y Sanathoi Devi (Arjuna Awardee) has won the silver for India in 52kg category after losing to China's Luan Zhang .
- Uchit Sharma (52kg), Suraya Bhanu Pratap Singh (60kg) and Monika (56kg) categories secured the silver medal.
- Pooja Kadian (75kg) category secured the lone bronze medal.

5. Indian shuttler has finished runners-up at Bitburger Grand Prix Gold badminton tournament at Saarbrucken in Germany\_\_**Sourabh Verma.**



- Sourabh went down 19-21 20-22 fighting to Shi Yuqi (World No.16) of China in a clash of the Bitburger Open tournament.
- It was his 3rd runners-up finish this season.

6. Who will be once again goodwill ambassador when her doping ban expires in April next year and she returns to International Tennis competition\_\_**Maria Sharapova**.



- The UN Development Programme (UNDP) appointed the tennis star as a goodwill ambassador in February 2007, but suspended her in March after her she failed a drug test.
- Earlier, Sharapova's 24 months ban for testing positive for Meldonium was cut to 15 months by the Lausanne-based Court of Arbitration for sport..

7. Who has won 33rd Indian Oil Servo Surjit Hockey Tournament for the first time by beating Army XI\_\_**Punjab National Bank of Delhi**.



- Punjab National Bank (PNB) of Delhi has won 33rd IndianOil Servo Surjit Hockey Tournament for the first time by beating Army XI with a 6-5 at Burlton Park in Jalandhar (Punjab).
- The decision of the match came from penalty shootouts.

8. The Women's carrom team has defeated Sri Lanka to win the gold at the 7th World Carrom Championship in Birmingham (UK)\_\_**India**.



- S. Apoorwa and Kajol Kumari brought the first gold medals in the women's doubles event of the World championship.

9. Who will host the 2018 Invictus Games for wounded military personnel\_\_ **Australia**.



- More than 500 serving and former personnel from 17 nations will compete in the multi-sports competition in Sydney(Australia).
- Athletes, who have been wounded, injured (become ill in service) will compete in both individual and team sports including swimming, archery, cycling, track and field and wheelchair rugby.

10. Who has become the brand ambassador for T20 Blind Cricket World Cup 2017\_\_\_\_ **Rahul Dravid**.



- The tournament will be played from January 28th January to 12th February 2017.
